

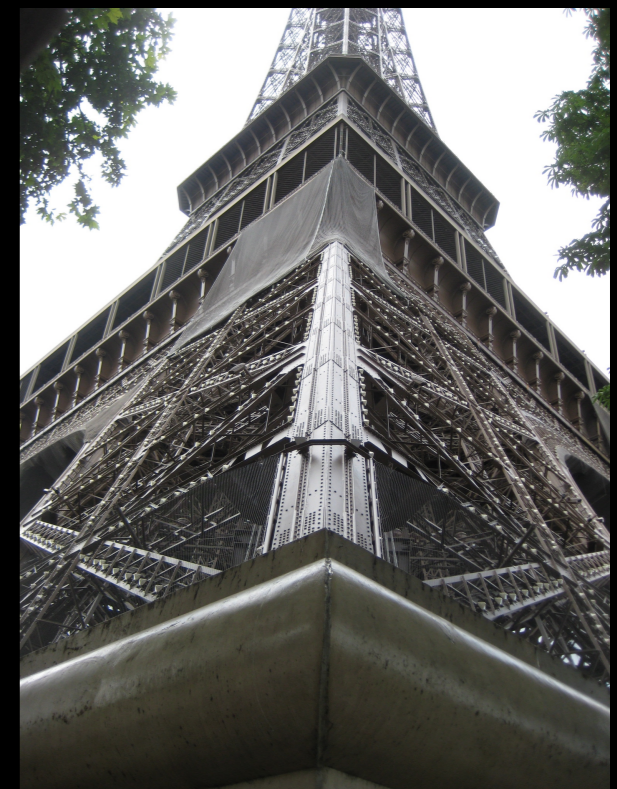

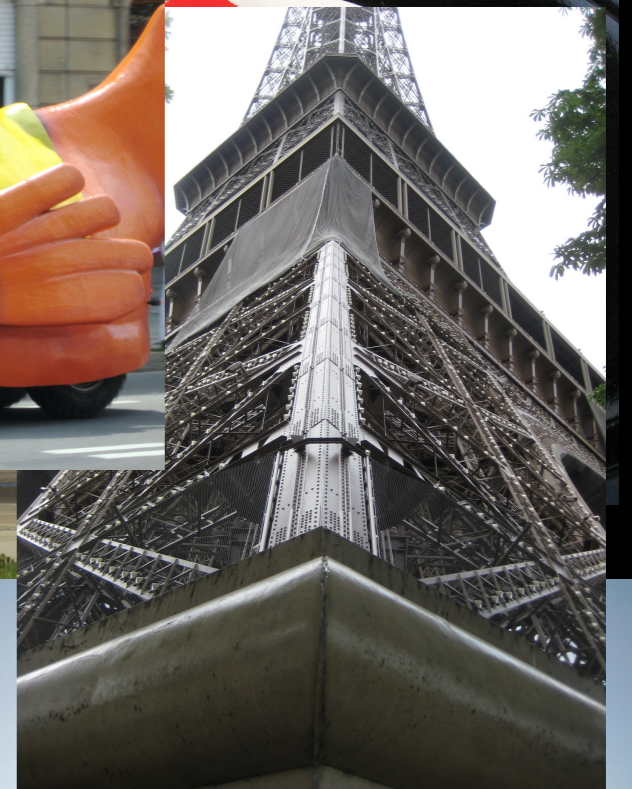
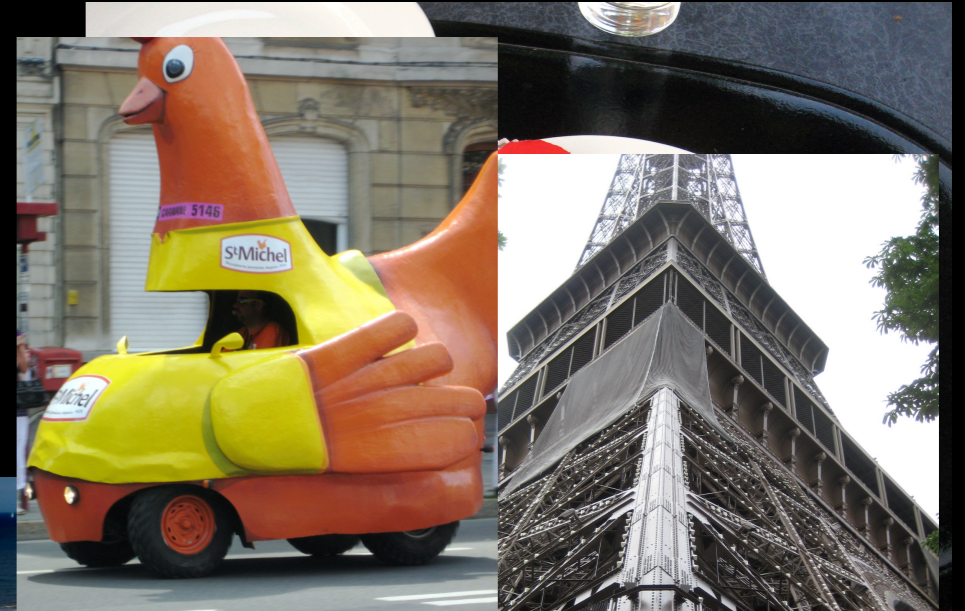

- No automatic image display

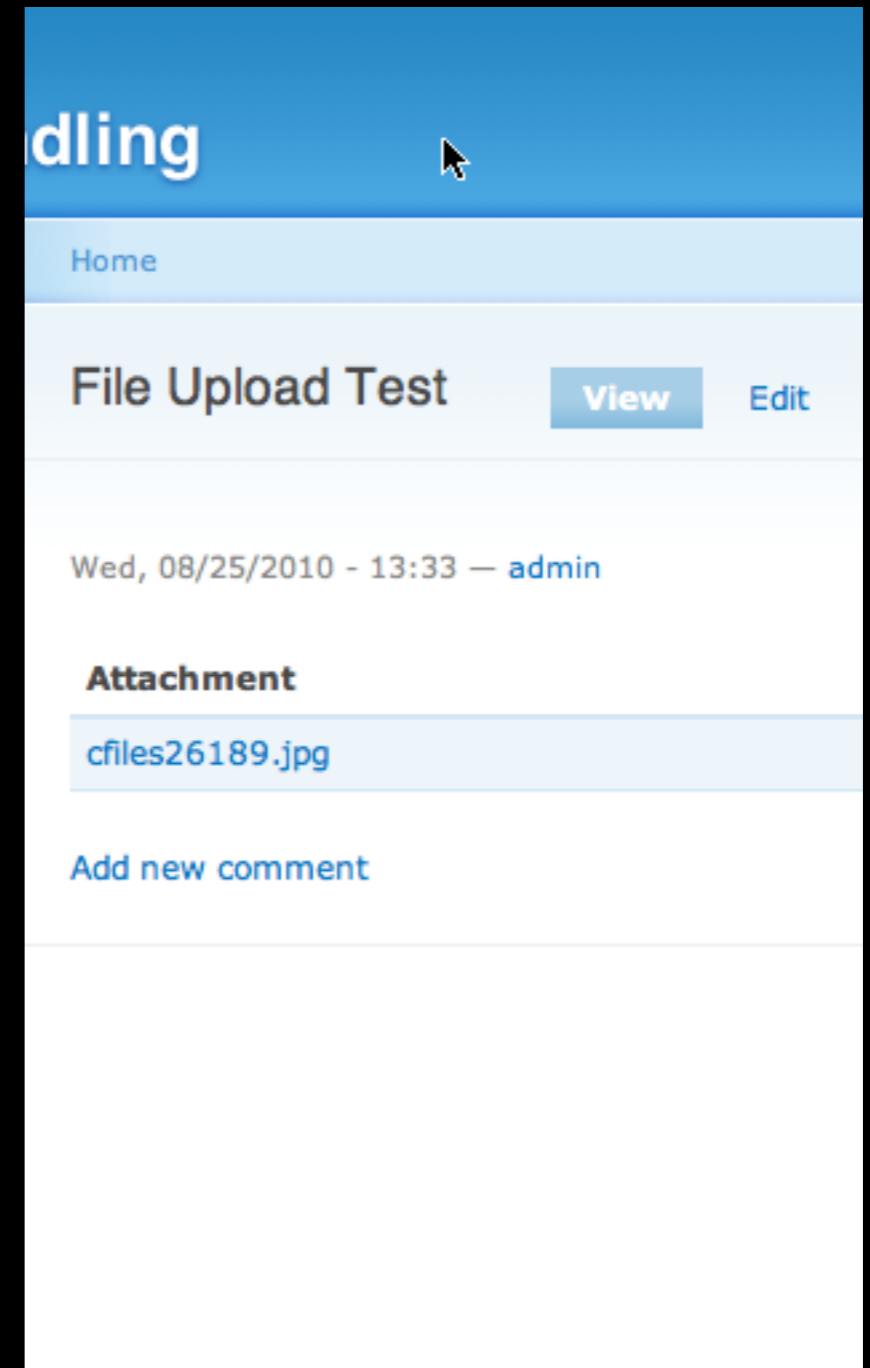
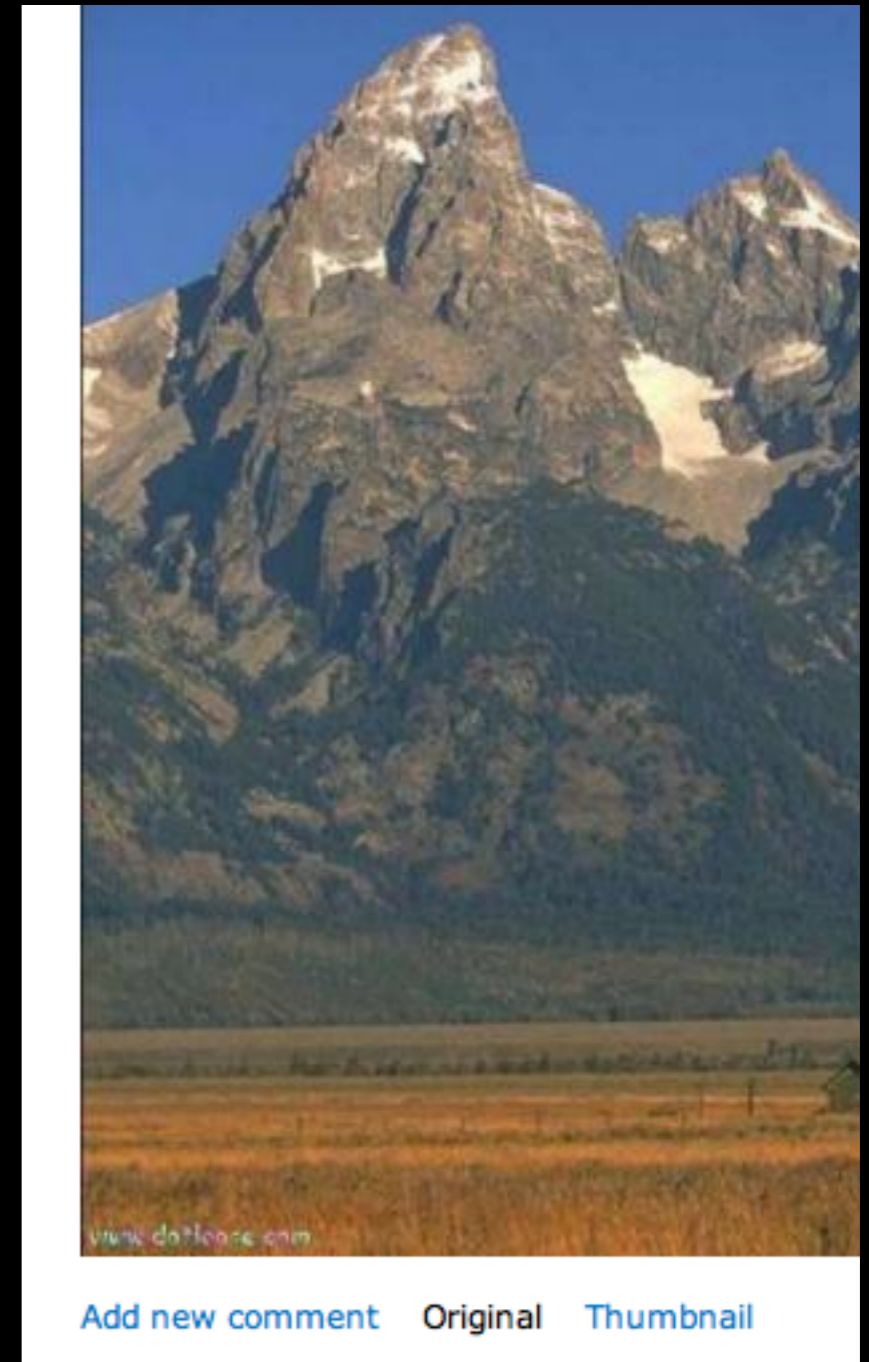


Image Module

- Does not utilize Imagefield

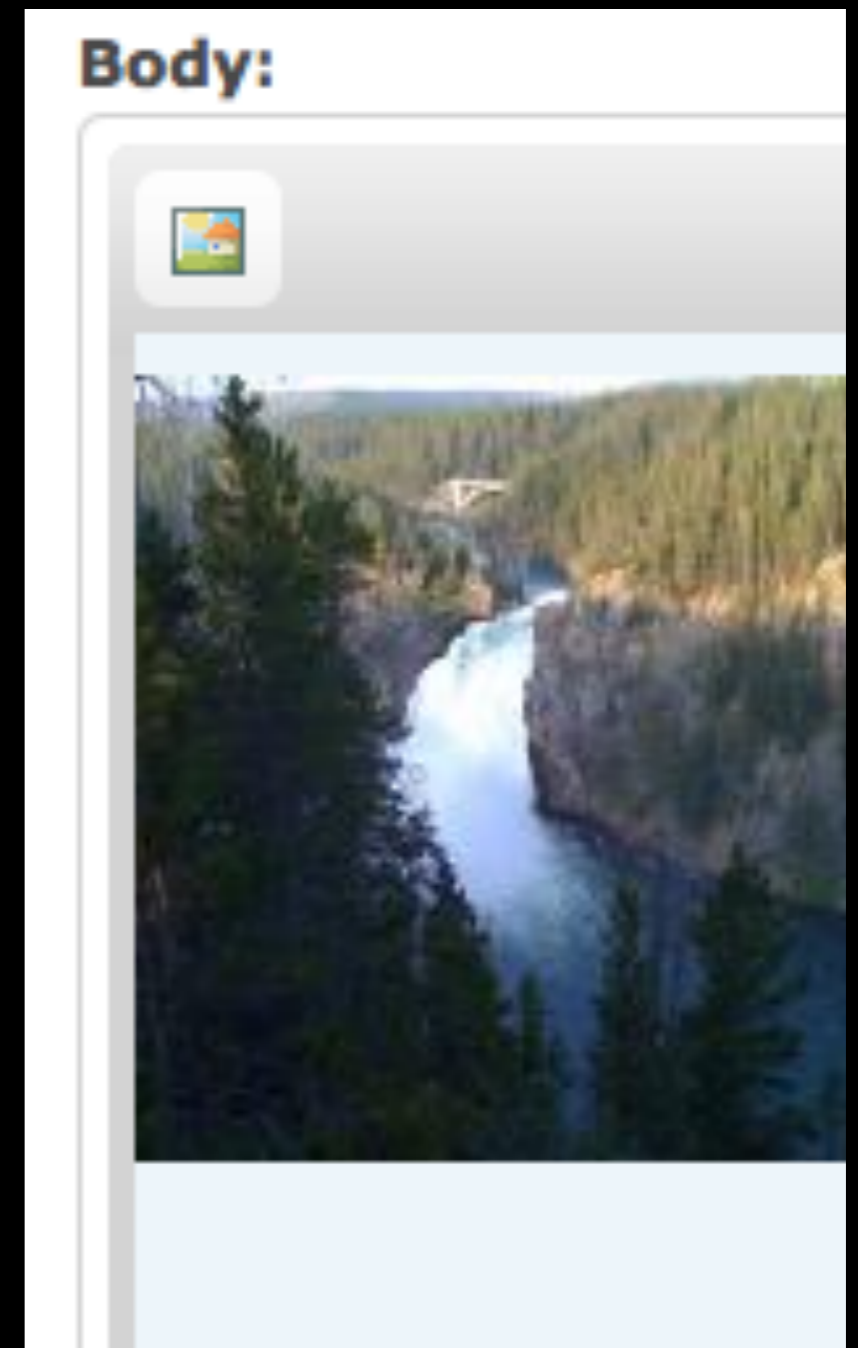
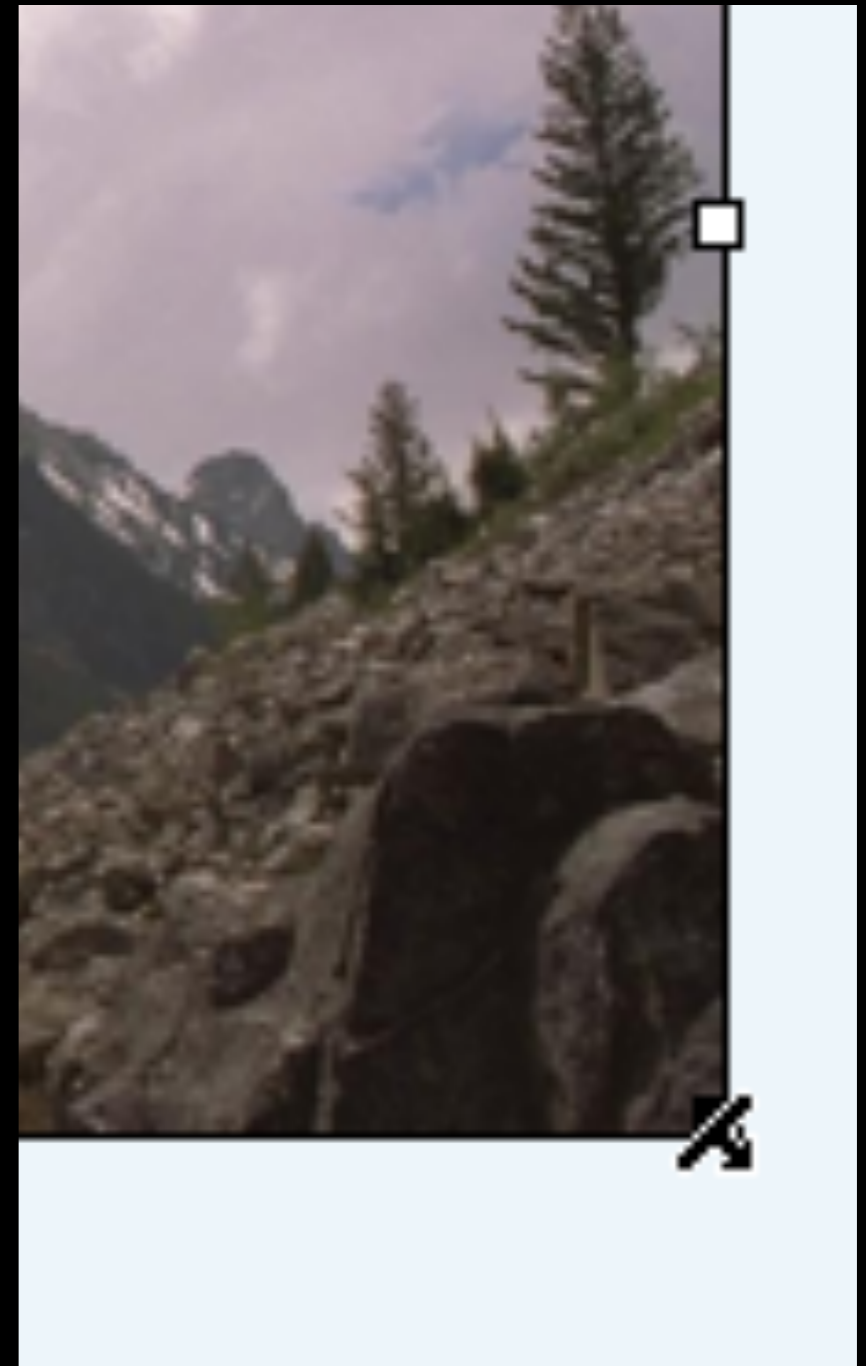


Image Resize Filter

- Drag to resize images in the WYSIWYG editor
- Leverages IMCE and ImageCache



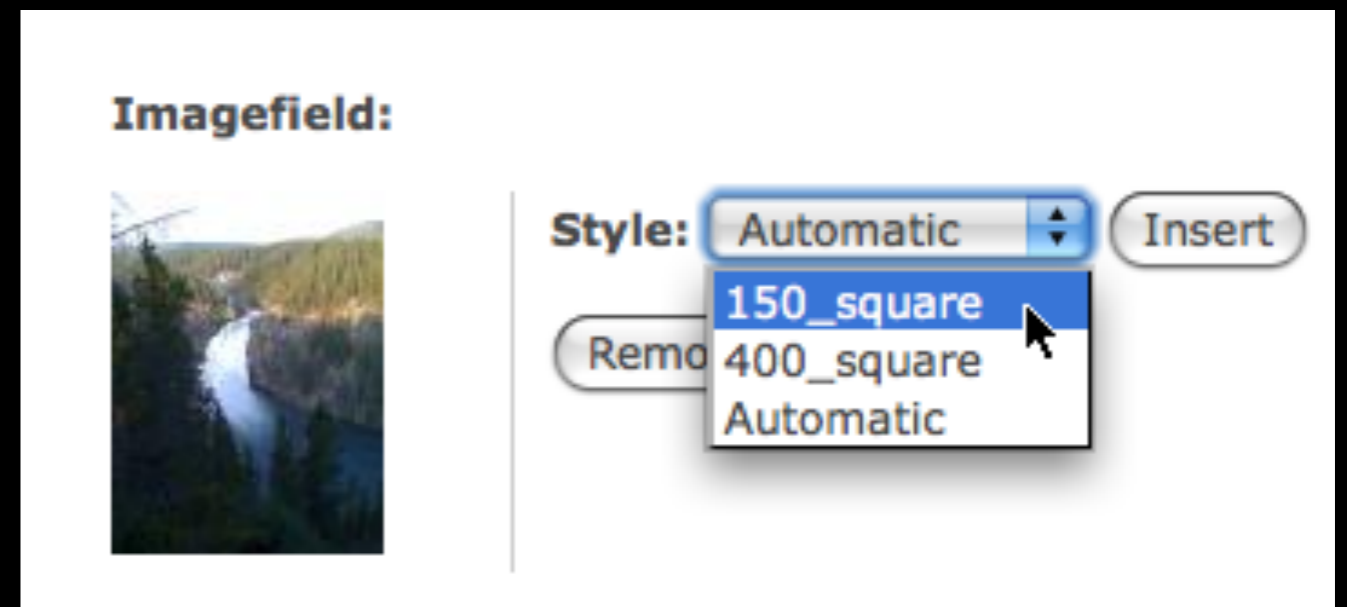
Imagefield Crop

- Drupal.org/project/imagefield_crop
- Drag to resize and crop images in the browser
- Operates outside of the WYSIWYG editor



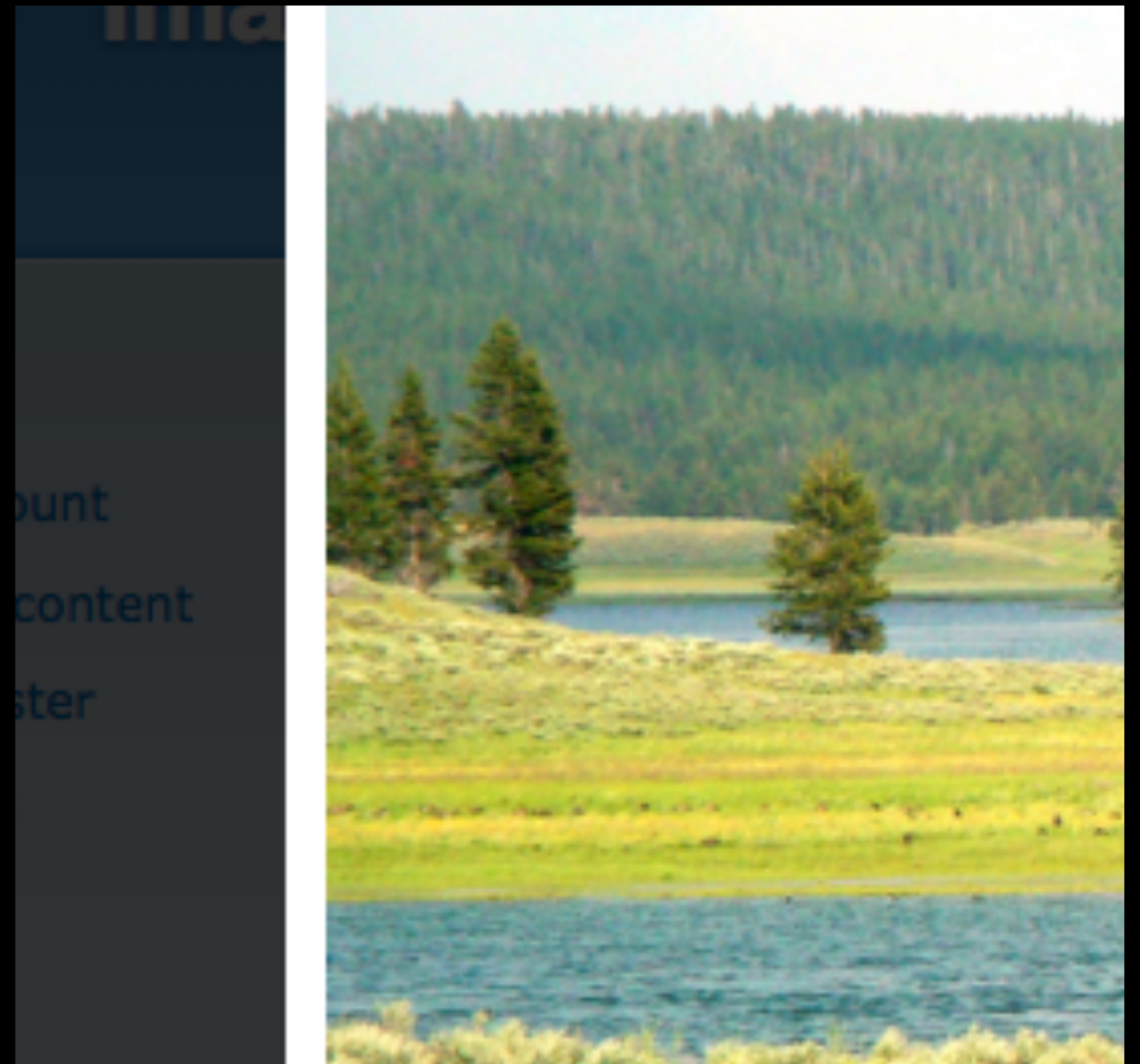
Insert Module

- Drupal.org/project/insert
- Select ImageCache preset to resize image
- Resized image sent to WYSIWYG editor



Lightbox Module

- Slick way for end-users to view full-size images
